

How to: Make a Fringed Flower

Type 2:

1. Cut a strip 1cm wide strip from either printer paper or construction paper. Then, slowly make small cuts every 1-1.5mm across the long edge of the strip. Make sure you leave at least 8-10mm distance to the base of the paper. This way, you get a deep fringe with a narrow base.
2. Then, cut a narrow strip of paper (it looks nicer if it is a different color than the main flower) and attach it to the bottom portion of the fringe (the part that is not cut) with glue or tape so that the smaller portion sticks out before the rest of the fringe.
3. Roll the paper around the quilling tool/toothpick, starting with the narrow narrow strip of paper, and continue rolling the fringe. The narrow strip makes the center of the flower.
4. Glue the ends of the fringe. Let dry.
5. Peel the petals outward and remove the quilling tool/toothpick.
