Goddess Saraswati, the wife of Lord Brahma, is the Hindu Goddess of knowledge, music, and arts. Her four arms represent the four aspects of human learning: mind, intellect, alertness, and ego. Each of these four arms and the items in her hands represent the four Holy Vedas and three forms of literature. She holds a book of the sacred Vedas (the primary sacred book for Hindus), a garland of crystals (representing poetry), a pot of water from the Ganges (representing purity and prose), and a veena (representing the power of music and its ability to purify human thought).
